

Good afternoon all,

Thank you for your continued support and perseverance during this unusual school year. You are receiving this email because you have chosen to keep your student(s) virtual when we reopen our doors on October 5th. As stated in the Back to School Survey, the virtual option we can offer is a more hands-off version of class, where students would be assigned work to complete on their own, and have regular check-ins with their teachers, multiple times/week. However, on Wednesdays, all of Trinity Academy will be virtual, live, from 10am-3pm, just as we have been doing. So, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday will not be live with teachers. We are not able to offer live virtual classes when students are in the building because we do not have the staffing or technology.

My apologies if I was not clear with stating this exact breakdown at an earlier time. Per the church's and Board's concern with contact tracing, unfortunately, at this time, if you decide to keep your child virtual that will be through the New Year, when we come back from winter break on January 7th. We cannot offer an option for you to pick and choose days to send your student(s) to school. Before we break for winter recess, we will be checking back in to see if you would like to continue virtually or have your child return to school physically.
